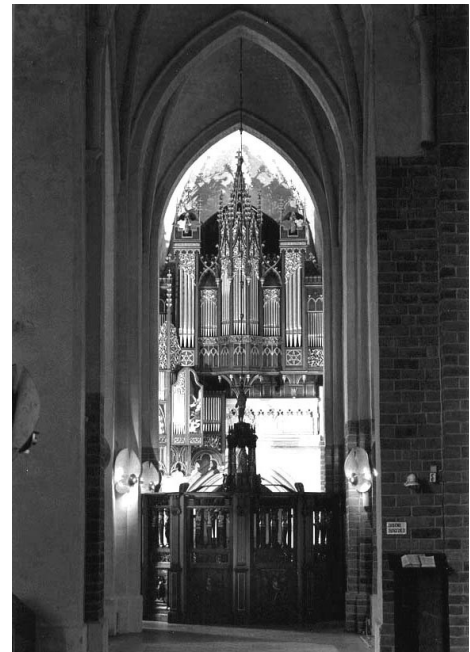

VÄSTERÅS CATHEDRAL, SWEDEN



The organ was built in 1898 by Åkerman & Lund, with three manuals and 40 stops. In 1927 the same firm added a four-stop Eko organ, together with a new console. The organ then remained with only minor changes until 1961, when Magnusson & Son converted the actions from pneumatic to electro-pneumatic, replaced the console and provided several new stops.

The work of 1998 is based on the organ of 1898/1927 and includes the re-instatement of certain ranks which had subsequently been removed or transposed. At the same time, the Swell and Eko organs have been enlarged; two Bombarde reeds and the Pedal Untersatz 32ft have been added. The organ retains its original Roosevelt actions, which have been fully restored; additional chests have been made in the same style. The organ has been entirely renovated and a new console has been provided - the fourth in the organ's history.
