The organ was built by J. W. Walker & Sons in 1891, and was rebuilt by them in 1934. The organ stands in a large chamber on the north side of the chancel, with openings to the south and west.

The organ suffered damaged in the Second World War, and was much altered subsequently. In 2012 it was enlarged and completely reconstructed as a new instrument. It retains the style and character of the 1891 organ, and is based on the original pipework.
