

# ST CLEMENT DANES, LONDON

The organ, though considerably larger than that built by Father Smith, stands in a handsome carved oak case which is an echo of the Smith case and of almost the same dimensions. This case was designed by W.A.S. Lloyd, the Architect of the restored Church, in consultation with Ralph Downes, who was responsible for the layout and tonal finishing of the organ. The front pipes, from the Great and Pedal Diapasons and Octaves, the Choir Principal and the Pedal Flute, are of a seventy-five per cent tin alloy.
