

CROYDON MINSTER



The organ was built by Hill & Son in 1869 with casework by Sir Gilbert Scott. In 1893 it was moved to the north side of the Chancel, and a separate case for the Choir Organ, one bay further east, was designed by J. Oldrid Scott. The organ was completely reconstructed in 1904, and the Solo Organ was added in 1912.

Harrison & Harrison overhauled the organ in 1969, and provided electro-pneumatic action and a detached console; a few tonal changes were made, to plans by Roy Massey and Michael Fleming.

In 2000 the console was renovated and the coupling and combination actions replaced.

ACCESSORIES

Eight general pistons and general cancel piston
Seven foot pistons to the Pedal Organ
Six pistons to the Choir Organ
Seven pistons to the Great Organ
Eight pistons to the Swell Organ (duplicated by foot pistons)
Five pistons to the Solo Organ
Cancel piston to each division
Reversible pistons: *I-IV, IX, X, XII, XIII, XVII*; 1
Reversible foot pistons: *II, XII*; 11
Sequencer, operating general pistons
The pistons are adjustable with eight divisional and 128 general memories
Balanced expression pedals to the Swell and Solo Organs

The manual compass is 58 notes; the pedal 30 notes.
