

ST GEORGE'S CHURCH CULLERCOATS, TYNE & WEAR

The church, with its superb broach spire, was designed by J. L. Pearson and occupies a prominent position overlooking the North Sea.

The organ was built by T. C. Lewis in 1885; it was restored by Harrison & Harrison in 1987. It stands on the south side of the chancel.
