

# MORNINGSIDE PARISH CHURCH, EDINBURGH

The church dates from 1890. Originally known as St Matthew's Church and later as Cluny Parish Church, it was renamed Morningside Parish Church in 2004.

Henry Willis & Sons built the organ in 1901, at which time it had two manuals and fourteen stops, with a third manual and a further 14 stops prepared for.

The organ was rebuilt in 1929 by Rushworth & Dreaper. A new console and pneumatic actions were provided, and a new wind system was installed. The specification was completed, including the addition of the Choir Organ, but with some differences from the original Willis scheme. The consultant was Dr Alfred Hollins.

In 1990 Rushworths converted the actions to electro-pneumatic and made some changes to the pipework.

The restoration in 2004 reinstated the 1929 specification with minor variations.

Reversible foot pistons: *Great to Pedal, Swell to Great*

Combination couplers: *Great & Pedal pistons, Generals on Swell foot pistons*

Eight general and eight divisional piston memory levels

The manual compass is 56 notes, the pedal 30 notes
