HEREFORD CATHEDRAL



Renatus Harris built an organ for the Cathedral in 1686. It stood on the pulpitum at the entrance to the quire. This organ was enlarged on several occasions during the eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries. The Cathedral was closed in 1841 for major repairs, during which the organ was dismantled and the pulpitum removed; in 1849 the organ was temporarily reerected in the nave.



In 1864 Gray & Davison rebuilt the organ on the south side of the quire, with the present colourful display of front pipes designed by Gilbert Scott. Henry Willis altered and enlarged this instrument in 1879, and in 1892 he completely rebuilt it in its present form, virtually as a new organ though retaining some of the old pipework. The Willis firm made a few changes and additions in 1909; in 1933 they installed electro-pneumatic actions and a detached console on the north side of the choir stalls, making some more changes to the pipework but avoiding fundamental alterations.

In 1978 the organ was restored by Harrison & Harrison, and nine new stops were provided. The Choir Organ was brought forward into the lower

part of the case, where the console was formerly placed; and the Tuba was re-sited in a prominent position at the top of the organ.

The organ was cleaned and renovated in 2004.
