

ST AUGUSTINE'S CHURCH, PENARTH

The magnificent Butterfield church of St Augustine in Penarth overlooks Cardiff Bay. The organ was built by Hill & Son in 1895. The specification has survived without change, though new electro-pneumatic actions were fitted in 1966. In 2000 the organ was comprehensively overhauled.
