The organ was built in 1927 for the ballroom of Glen Tanar House, Aberdeenshire. Lord Glentanar presented it to the Temple Church in 1954; the layout was re-designed for the new organ chamber, and the 32ft Double Ophicleide was added, but no other changes were made. The organ case, designed by W. E. Godfrey, was installed in 1966.

The organ was fully restored in 2011 - 13.
