

TRUMPINGTON PARISH CHURCH CAMBRIDGE

Joseph Walker supplied "a barrel and finger organ with seven stops and a single barrel" in 1851. This organ was rebuilt and enlarged to its present size by Miller of Cambridge in 1902.

In 1929 the organ was overhauled and revoiced by Harrison & Harrison, and was moved to a new west gallery. Minor changes were made in 1957 and 1975.

In 2003 Harrison & Harrison overhauled the organ and installed three new stops on the Swell.
