Lake Forest is on the shore of Lake Michigan, a few miles north of downtown Chicago.

The organ in the Church of the Holy Spirit, built by Harrison & Harrison in 1972, was originally installed in the north transept. In 1995 it was enlarged and completely rebuilt on the north side of the chancel, with a new casework of oak.

ACCESSORIES

Eight general pistons (duplicated by foot pistons)
Eight foot pistons to the Pedal Organ
Eight pistons each to the Choir, Great and Swell Organs
General cancel piston

The pistons are adjustable, with eight general and eight divisional memories
Two balanced expression pedals, with three sets of shutters: Swell Chancel, Swell Nave, Choir

Reversible pistons: I, II, III, V, VI, VII
Reversible foot pistons: II, III, VII
Reversible piston and foot piston to Full Organ, with indicator

The console is detached and mobile
The actions are electro-pneumatic
The manual compass is 61 notes; the pedal 32 notes
